TIPG 2020 will address the main issues of contemporary political geography and international relations. The Conference provides a platform for discussion and collaboration of experts in the fields of Political Geography, Geopolitics, International Relations, International Law and other related areas of inquiry.

The Conference is a continuation of the International Conference “Topical issues of international relations in the current geopolitical context”, which has been taken place in St. Petersburg annually since 2016.

TIPG 2020 invites **paper submissions** and **speakers** on **topics**: Political Geography, Human Geography, Urban Studies, Demography & Population Studies, Migration Politics, Natural Sources Politics, International Organizations and Integration, Conflicts & Security, International Law.

The conference will include **four panels**:

Panel 1: Migration and socio-demographic processes;
